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STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER GEOFFREY STARKS

WASHINGTON, March 18, 2025—Federal Communications Commission Commissioner Geoffrey Starks issued the following statement:

Serving the American people as a Commissioner on the Federal Communications Commission has been the honor of my life.
