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PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU AND OFFICE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY GRANT EXTENSION OF PUBLIC INPUT DEADLINE

WC Docket No. 18-89, ET Docket No. 21-232, EA Docket No. 21-233

By this Public Notice, the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB) and Office of Engineering and Technology (OET) partially grant the Motion for Extension of Time to File Comments filed by 5G Automotive Association, Alliance for Automotive Innovation, Autonomous Vehicle Industry Association, Autos Drive America, Consumer Technology Association, CTIA, and The Intelligent Transportation Society of America (collectively, the Petitioners).¹ Specifically, we find that good cause exists to grant the motion for extension of time to file public input in response to a recent Public Notice released in the above-captioned dockets, until June 27, 2025.

On May 23, 2025, PSHSB and OET jointly released a Public Notice² requesting public input by June 9, 2025, on whether the Commission's Covered List³ should be updated to include certain communications equipment and services on the basis of a recent Commerce Department determination relating to connected vehicles.

Petitioners request an extension of the public input deadline to June 30, 2025, to provide sufficient time "to enable stakeholders to fully consider how to help the Commission avoid challenges that could undermine national security goals" in light of the "novel" questions raised in the *May Public Notice*.⁴

While national security concerns in the ordinary course require us to act as expeditiously as possible, and although the Commission's policy is that extensions of time shall not be routinely granted,⁵ we find that it is in the public interest to grant the request for an extension. We find this reasonable, because the Petitioners seek in good faith to provide substantive input with the goal of informing the Commission on how best to implement and enforce the proposed update to the Covered List. The Commission might benefit in receiving such complete and thorough recommendations. Accordingly, we find good cause to support the Petitioners' request for an extension of time and extend the deadline for providing public input to June 27, 2025, which will be a full five weeks following the *May Public Notice*.
